### **CHAASE SPRING BANQUET**

Every year, outstanding students, preceptors, and friends of the University of Wisconsin-Eau Claire Health Care Administration program are recognized at the annual spring banquet hosted by the UW-Eau Claire Center for Health Administration and Aging Services Excellence (CHAASE). This year's event was held on April 18th at The Lismore in Eau Claire, WI.

This year's keynote speaker was Dr. Megan Gerhardt, Professor of Management and Leadership at the Farmer School of Business at Miami University, where she also serves as the Robert D. Johnson Director of Leadership Development.

Dr. Gerhardt speaks and consults with top organizations around the world on ways to leverage generational diversity in the workplace. In addition to her academic research, she is author of the book Gentelligence: A Revolutionary Approach to Leading an Intergenerational Workforce. Dr. Gerhardt's Gentelligence work has been showcased as Harvard Business Review's Big Idea in March 2022 and was also chosen as one of Harvard Business Review's Top 10 Must Reads for 2024. Dr. Gerhardt's work on leveraging generational diversity has also been featured in the Wall Street Journal, Time Magazine, NBC News, The Washington Post, and CNN, among others. All of Dr. Gerhardt's work (<u>www.profgerhardt.com</u>) focuses on leveraging unique differences to achieve impact and extraordinary levels of performance.
