

UW-EAU CLAIRE CONVEYANCE VAN PROGRAM

Rides from the Conveyance Van are based off of Medical Need only. You will be required to provide a written Doctor's note or SSD office referral within 1 week of the first ride.

Operating hours are **Monday-Thursday: 7:40 AM-9:00 PM** and **Fridays: 7:40 am-5:00 pm**

Rides will not be offered during Spring Break, Winterim, or Summer.

Scheduling Rides

- You must fill out the attached second page, Request for Transportation, in order to start the ride service.
- Rides will be offered on the 10s, 20s, 30s, and 40s of every hour. (For example: 9:10, 9:20, 9:30, 9:40)
 - Please note, if your class starts at 8:00 AM, rides will be offered at 7:40 AM and 7:45 AM.
- Please look at the attached map for designated pick-up and drop-off locations. The Conveyance Van drivers will follow this map for rides to and from campus buildings.
- If you are here during finals week, your modified schedule for Finals week must be submitted by either Dec 1st or May 1st.
- Permanent changes must be emailed to Blugold Central for further review. We will update your ride schedule accordingly.

Welcome Center: (715) 836-2544

- The Welcome Center must be contacted via phone 30 minutes in advance to cancel in order to avoid any penalties.
- If you do not require a previously scheduled evening ride, you **MUST** contact the Parking Office to cancel prior to 4:30pm.

Night Conveyance Riders

- If you have an evening class, the Conveyance van will run from 5:00pm-8:50pm Monday-Thursday. 8:50 will be the last ride time.
- In the evenings, please still call the Welcome Center. Phone will automatically transfer it to the Van phone.

Delay Time Between Riders

- Please be on time. We have a set schedule for all of our riders.
- To help ensure riders are picked up/dropped off on schedule, our drivers will wait no more than **3 minutes** after a scheduled pick-up time, before considering the rider a no show.
 - Any rider with **three** no shows will be contacted by the Parking Office and may lose all riding privileges. Your next option would be to utilize provided city transit with your Blugold ID.
- If the driver is late or a no show, please wait 10 minutes before calling to check on your ride.

Van Capacity

- Please be aware that you may not be the only student in the van during your ride time. We can accommodate up to 4 students at one time.
- Please be aware that we accommodate individuals with service dogs and wheelchairs. If you have an allergy to pets, please reach out prior to your ride start date.

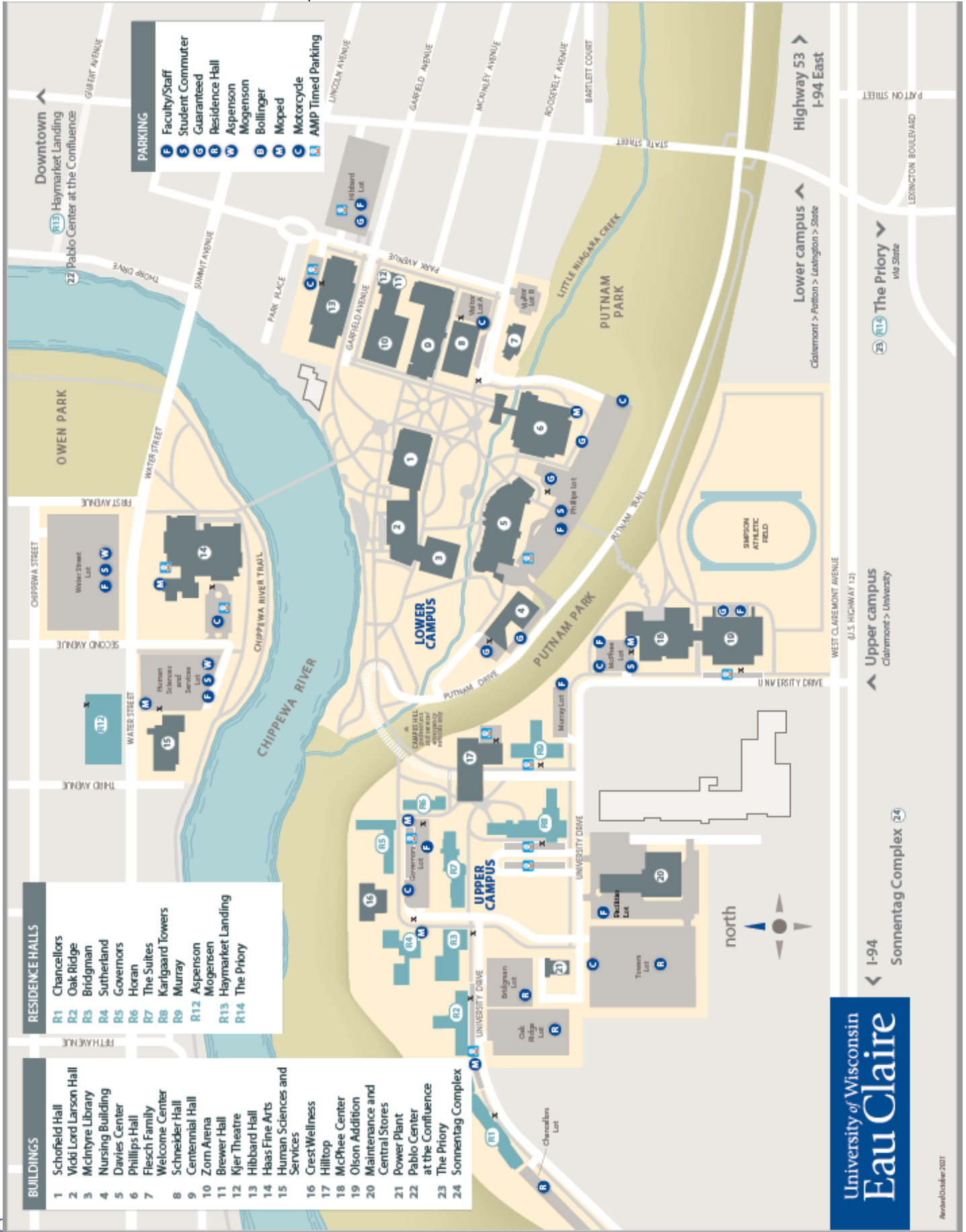
