## Get started with Pre-Nursing Curriculum

The pre-nursing curriculum includes generals and prerequisite courses. Required courses include general chemistry, biochemistry, human anatomy and physiology, microbiology, human development, statistics, communication/writing. These courses can be taken anywhere, including UW-Eau Claire main campus, but UW-Stevens Point at Marshfield is a convenient option as we share the same location. Check out the program plans online or meet with the Marshfield Site Director to start planning!

## Apply to the Marshfield Site

The application process has several steps. Connect with the Marshfield Site Director to request the program application and for assistance as you move through the process. The Marshfield Site admits a new cohort twice per year. You can apply in the Fall (due by December 1) or the Spring (due by May 1). ## Professional Nursing Curriculum

Throughout the core nursing courses students build knowledge and skills through didactic learning, hands-on learning in skills and simulations, and real-life practice in clinical rotations. Students, get to explore and experience different specialties throughout the program including pediatrics, obstetrics, mental health, public health, critical care, and more! There are also many opportunities to get involved with student organizations.

Our BSN graduates are actively recruited for positions, and nearly 100% have jobs or are continuing their education within a year of graduation.

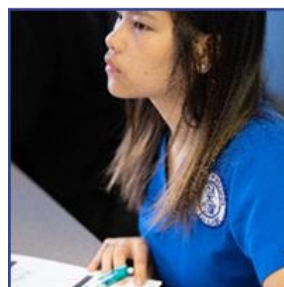

# The UW-Eau Claire & Marshfield Advantage

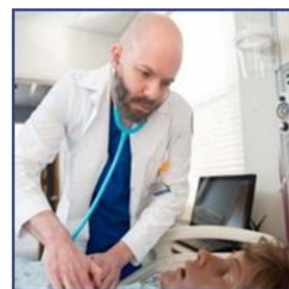
Students earn the same high-quality BSN degree as students on the main UW-Eau Claire Campus and attend commencement together. Having a BSN degree is connected to a higher rate of professional advancement, as BSN-educated nurses are needed to fill many positions (including leadership and management roles). Our BSN program prepares students as a generalist to provide professional nursing in a variety of areas.



Courses are taught by UW-Eau Claire faculty located both in Marshfield (via face-to-face instruction) and in Eau Claire (via distance education). The nursing curriculum combines theory courses with hands-on experiences to grow well-rounded nurses. Nursing skills are taught by hands-on learning methods.



Students learn and build their nursing skills in the Clinical Learning Center (CLC) and through their clinical rotations. Students get to learn safely in the CLC skills and simulation labs, while also getting real life experience at the Marshfield Medical Center in a wide variety of clinical units.



There are many opportunities to get involved! Student organizations do in community activities such as meals for families at the Ronald McDonald House and highway cleanup (pictured). Students can also participate in nurse residencies/internships and engage in collaborative research projects with faculty.



The Marshfield Site is conveniently located at the UW-Stevens Point at Marshfield campus. Dedicated physical space for UWEC includes a Student Success Center, Clinical Learning Center Skills Lab & Simulation Lab, group/meeting spaces, faculty offices, etc. Students also have access to the entire UW-Stevens Point at Marshfield campus such as food service, library, study areas, wellness center, commons areas and walking trails.
