



ROCK CLIMBING

All players must show their Blugold ID Card before every game to participate.

A. PLAYER ATTIRE

- a. Shoes and harnesses can be provided
- b. Personal equipment is permitted
- c. Players will need to purchase a rope wall pass, along with the intramural team fee

B. THE GAME

- a. Teams consist of 2 (two) players within the Men's Women's and Co-Rec Leagues
- b. Participants are eligible to compete on one single gender and co-rec team
- c. Participants are expected to treat staff, judges, and other competitors with respect
- d. Violation of the above expectation are grounds for weekly or seasonal disqualification

C. CLOCK

- a. This will be conducted in a standard four (4) week regular season
- b. Teams can climb anytime Monday – Friday during open hours at the bouldering or rope wall for their climbs to count

D. SCORING

- a. When counting a climb for a score, participants must have an official judge watching
- b. Each team member has 3 official attempts per route, after which they can no longer get a score for that route
- c. After each team member gets two official scores, those scores are locked in, and cannot be replaced by higher scores
- d. Both team members must score at least one route per week or no points will be given for that week
- e. After four weeks the team with the highest cumulative score will win in each league
- f. Weekly standings will be posted after scores are processed
- g. Each week will have a different range of climbing grades and styles
- h. Points will be based on the difficulty of the climb

E. TIEBREAKER

- a. A hole is predetermined before the tournament as the tie breaker hole. In the event of a tie, the tournament supervisor will determine who shot the lowest score on the tie breaker hole. If teams are still tied, a succeeding hole will be used to break the tie.

F. PLAYER CONDUCT

- a. Abusive or insulting language, acts of unfair play will result in suspension.

G. RULES

- a. Each team member may count two climbs for their weekly score
- b. Participants may work on any climb they want, as much as they want throughout the week
- c. EAC Staff are to be the main resource for judging active climbers
- d. If the current EAC Staff is busy, Eau Climbers Executive Board members, who are also EAC Staff, are allowed to be a sit-in judge
